


**Vernal Equinox (Spring begins) -

God's Location: China

Gender/Nature: Female

Rules Over: Sacrificial Offerings, Farming, Plowing, Earthquakes



This God was once living in a constellation far away from Earth. The Emperor of Heaven felt sorry about the people of Earth who were starving and decided to help them so he contacted Shujun and this is how the Ox God came to Earth.

The Emperor of Heaven told Shujun to bring the message to the people of Earth that if they work hard they will have a meal every three days but Shujun didn't understand the Emperor well and told people that if they work hard they will have three meals every day.

This incident made the Emperor very angry and instructed Shujun to come down to Earth and create oxen that would help people with farming and food production.

The Ox God is a legendary culture hero of ancient times in China. He instructed many Chinese Emperors (e.g. Huangdi, the Yellow Emperor) on perfecting agricultural practice and productivity. He invented the Ox-Cart.

It is believed that nowadays, Shujun is one of the guardians of Hell.

Here we have the ultimately supreme Heavenly Ruler of Chinese Mythology. Jade was the creator of the Universe and a Lord of the "Imperial Court", responsible for judging Gods, Humans and all living things.

When the Universe was first created it was chaotic and dark. Emperor Jade helped bring light and balance/order to the Cosmos. This supreme God achieved perfect Godliness by spending a billion centuries meditating and receiving enlightenment from the Cosmos. After becoming the Heavenly Ruler, his words became the Law and other Gods admitted that He was the one and only ruler of the Heavens. Earthly Emperors were ruling the Earth under Jade's "Mandate of Heaven". The Heavenly Emperor had countless servants and followers who made sure that His word and the Law would be obeyed. Every year, these followers filed an annual report to Jade with all the important incidents that happened on Earth during the past year. He was famous for being a Dragon-Ruler on his own. Ao Chin ruled over all the seas of planet Earth.

Along with Nu-Gua, the Creator Goddess, they gave life to thousands of species who then inhabited the oceans.

Ao Chin's favorite sea was the Pacific Ocean and especially the region closer to the lands south of modern China.

This God had the ability to take the form of a Spirit and he could be evoked by wise humans and other Gods.

Sailors and Ship Captains had specific ceremonies to evoke Ao Chin for help when there was trouble during sea travelling.

This strong and wise Spirit-God once entered the challenge to command a Dragon on his own and he was the first among Gods who managed to succeed.

Seiryuu, the Azure Dragon God or God of Slaughter is one of the four Gods who guard and observe the world from the four directions of the compass/horizon. The other three guardians are the Vermillion Bird or Ling Guang, the White Tiger or Jian Bing and the Black Tortoise or Zhi Ming.

There's also a fifth deity that governs the Center and is also a Dragon called Huang-Long (Yellow Dragon). The element of the Azure Dragon God is the Water and he usually appears to govern the East. He is also associated with Spring and it is believed that he guided many Chinese Emperors (e.g. the Tang Dynasty and the Liao Dynasty) for thousands of years in the journey for evolution and progress.

This God had the ability to confuse others and make them unable to comprehend him. In Japan the God of Slaughter is said to guard the cities and protect from intruders this is why many Japanese cities have temples dedicated to him. Both the Chinese and the Japanese celebrate the coming of Spring with a special ceremony every year dedicated to the Azure Dragon.

This Supreme Goddess was one of the four famous "Bodhisattvas" (very important deities of Chinese Buddhism) and her mission was to protect the innocent, the poor, all the people who suffered.

Her resume consisted of many cases where she prevented poverty from establishing in houses, she offered food for those who were hungry and she gave comfort to individuals who were suffering. One characteristic of Guan Yin was that she never accepted something in return for her aid. She was also known in India (as Avalokitesvara) and in Japan (as Kannon) and in many other places all around Earth. After accepting much enlightenment she was offered a place in the Heavens along with the other Buddhas. Guan Yin was pleased but when she was about to lift off she heard the crying babies looking for her and she decided to stay on Earth and become a protector of the planet. This Deity was evoked very often by those who were in trouble and this happens until nowadays. She could take the form of any living thing but she preferred to appear in a human female form. Guan Yin was well known for her ability to make a woman fertile.

Cao Gojiu was a Chinese Emperor when he was human. He hated the corruption in China and he decided to become a monk in a meditation monastery in the mountains.

While meditating he discovered another God who was ancient and powerful. His name was Lu-Dong-Bin.

They become friends and Cao Guojiu was taught immortality and the knowledge of the "Elixir of Immortality".

After becoming a powerful and knowledgeable entity, Cao-Guojou decided to patronage actors and then all performers.

He continued his brilliant career by teaching the secrets of the Theater art to wannabe actors and entertainers.

This powerful Chinese God was one of the "Eight Immortals" (more about them later) and he is one of the strangest and more eccentric deities of the Chinese Pantheon.

He enjoyed making people's lives difficult and mixing situations and things. Lan Caihe was a herb seller when he was human and he enjoyed drinking alcohol and consuming various drugs. Some say he had a female nature (could be he was a "She" when he was a human). This God earned "Immortality" when he helped another God who disguised as a beggar and asked to be healed and treated. Lan Caihe helped the beggar and he was generously rewarded. Immortality changed Lan Caihe a lot. From being a caring and loving deity towards humans he started hating them for their ignorance and greed. Once, he made an important deal with a human king who betrayed him and from then on Lan Caihe decided to become the God of poverty destroying the fortunes of humans. After messing the lives of many people (unless they obeyed His commands), Lan Caihe was given the title: "God of Poverty". This is not a deity you want to hang around with.



One of the most worshipped and infamous Chinese Deities is Sun Wukong, the Monkey God. He was the hero of the amazing novel "Journey to the West", written by notorious writer Wu-Cheng-En in the 16th Century. This novel is a must-read for all those looking for enlightenment and spiritual guidance.

The Monkey God was born a very long time ago and he was a selfish and arrogant entity. He always enjoyed pranks. Soon he became King of the Apes but he had a huge fear, the fear of Death. So, Sun Wukong decided to seek "Immortality" and he became a follower of Father Subodhi who was a DAOist Sage. It was then that the Monkey God was given the title: "Disciple Aware of Emptiness". This Chinese God was the God of the Dead and he was considered one of the most powerful entities of the Chinese Pantheon (people still worship this God in China and other Asian countries). He had the title of the "Lord of the 5th Floor of Hell".

Yen Lu Wang was ruler of the 1st Floor of Hell but Entities of Heaven accused him of treating souls well. When he was ruler of the 1st Floor of Hell, the Heavens were filled with souls and the place became crowded because Yen Lu Wang would send the souls to Heaven instead of sentencing them in the boiling Hell. The entities of Heaven wanted to prevent spiritual overpopulation and thus they advised Emperor Jade to move Yen Lu Wang to the 5th Floor of Hell so that the situation between Heaven and Hell would be balanced again. In the 5th Floor the God of Death made the sentenced souls feel as miserable as possible so that all Gods were happy again.

Yen Lu Wang had a team of five lethal assistants who carried his wishes to fulfillment. He knew everything about the actions and the thoughts of every man and woman (as well as the date of their death).

Guan Yu started as a mortal soya vendor. After a bizarre incident which involved the rescue of a harassed lady and the killing of a tax inspector, Guan Yu tasted battle for the first time. From then on he began a famous journey full of military quests and he became one of the "3 Brothers of the Peach Orchard".

The God of War preferred to avoid battles and confrontations (if this was possible) but his bravery and strong mind were legendary.

After much enlightenment he also became patron God of Policemen because he enjoyed defending Law and Justice.

Guan Yu had a sensitive soul and heart. He enjoyed literature and he was famous for reading a whole page of a Confucius text without blinking his eyes.

Here are their names: Cao-Guojiu: Royal Outcast, Han-Xiangzi: Flying Philosopher, Zhongli-Quan: God of Explosives, Zhang-Guolao: Stubborn Deity, Lu-Dongbin: God of Tactical Warfare, Li-Tieguai: Body Snatcher, Lan-Caihe: A Drunk & Disorientated Entity, He-Xiangu: God of Flowers.

Each of the 8 Immortals was associated with a different aspect of "DAOist" perfection. They formed their team over the centuries and because they were not enlightened enough to reach the "Heavens", they decided to stay on Earth and start their ventures on our mother-planet.

So, they went to the island of Penglai-Shan and established their base there. The Ba Xian went through a lot of quests and adventures according to the legends that exist today in the Eastern parts of the planet. 
